

About First Call Pregnancy Center

In 2003-04, a group of concerned individuals started praying about a recognized need for a pregnancy center in the lake area that would minister to the needs of those who were finding themselves in an unplanned pregnancy. A volunteer board of directors was formed and the first Director, Nancy Long was hired to coordinate training, policies and procedures, and set up the infrastructure of the "Center".

Land and a building were provided by Tim Porter in March of 2005. Many interested individuals from churches all over the Lake Oconee Area worked together to sheetrock, paint, wire, and furnish the new First Call Pregnancy Center. Many long hours were spent in completing the facility and training volunteers to staff the Center. The opening occurred on August 8th, 2005. In the first year of operation, additional trainings and affiliations were made with Care Net and Heartbeat International, long standing organizations with extensive experience in crisis pregnancy centers. In the first Year of seeing clients, we had 66 visits to the Center and saw 3 babies born.

In July of 2007, Margaret Keck became the first full time Executive Director of First Call Pregnancy Center. In January of 2008, the Board of Directors began the medical conversion process working with national affiliates to provide expert assistance in acquiring a grant from Focus on the Family to fund our first ultrasound machine. The move brought about hiring of additional staff and acquired a Medical Director. The tool of the ultrasound has been proven to make a significant difference in the choice a woman makes after seeing the beating heart of her baby and the movement of the infant within her womb. More than 85% of women choose LIFE! Since we opened in 2005, First Call Pregnancy Center has had more than 6250 visits; and 473 babies have been born by women that might have made a different choice if not for the services and resources that First Call provides.

We are a non-profit, non-political and non-denominational organization of Christians seeking to meet the physical, emotional, material, and spiritual needs of our clients. All of our services are FREE and CONFIDENTIAL. The center is committed to the Sanctity of Life and its purpose is to offer assistance to anyone, regardless of race, creed, religion, sex, or national origin who is in a crisis pregnancy.

First Call Pregnancy Center is a 501©3 and registered with the State of Georgia as a Charitable Organization. All gifts are tax deductible.

- 4. We shall not advise, provide or refer for abortion or abortifacients.
- 5. We encourage chastity as a positive lifestyle choice.

Our Commitment of Care:

- 1. Clients are served without regard to age, race income, nationality, religious affiliation, disability or other arbitrary circumstances.
- 2. Clients are treated with kindness, compassion and in a caring manner.
- 3. Clients always receive honest and open answers.
- 4. Client pregnancy tests are distributed and administered in accordance with all applicable laws.
- 5. Client information is held in strict and absolute confidence. Client information is only disclosed as required by law and when necessary to protect the client or others against imminent harm.
- 6. Clients receive accurate information about pregnancy, fetal development, lifestyle issues, and related concerns.
- 7. We do not offer, recommend or refer for abortions or abortifacients, but we are committed to offering accurate information about abortion procedures and risks.
- 8. All of our advertising and communications are truthful, honest and accurately describe the services we offer.
- 9. All of our staff and volunteers receive proper training to uphold these standards.

Statement of Faith

- We believe the Bible to be the inspired, infallible, authoritative Word of God.

I have agreed to enter into my role as a volunteer without any expectation of receiving any compensation for the services I may perform.

Volunteer Confidentiality Agreement

As a volunteer of First Call Pregnancy Center, it is important that confidentiality be protected. I agree that by signing this document all information regarding clients will be kept confidential. I will:

- 1. Prepare all necessary records, as instructed by my supervisor, being accurate and professional.
- 2. Physically safeguard records and other confidential information while in-house by keeping records locked up when not in use and not releasing information to others outside of the organization.
- 3. Release confidential information from records only with the expressed written permission of client or when law requires me.
- 4. Guard against informal violations of confidentiality by being discrete about what I discuss both inside and outside the organization.
- 5. Seek access only to the records in which I am professionally involved.
- 6. Continue to observe the confidentiality agreement after the termination of volunteer involvement.

If there is an infraction in regard to this agreement, that is grounds for immediate dismissal.

I agree to adhere to the guidelines set forth in this document. I am aware that certain information pertaining to internal matters of the organization should be maintained confidentially.

I am aware that if I suspect any child abuse or neglect, I must immediately notify the Client Services Supervisor or the Executive Director. I understand the issues of confidentiality in regard to these matters. I have been informed of the policy regarding liability, and my signature on this document indicates my understanding and acceptance.
